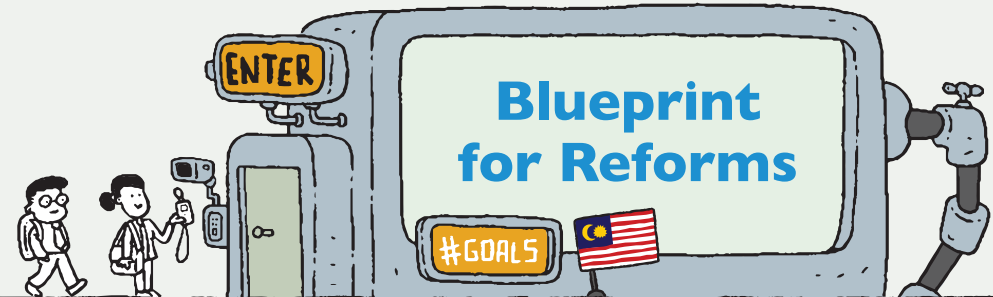


## Why These Reforms?

1. **Re-enacting Parliamentary Services Act:** To ensure Parliament manages its own affairs including hiring and budgeting.
2. **Empowering MPs:** To empower MPs and enhance parliamentary oversight through more select committees and designated Non-Governmental Business Time when Parliament sits.
3. **Regulating Constituency Development Fund:** To enact legislation to ensure equal allocation of constituency development funds to both government and opposition.
4. **Strengthening Election Offences Act:** To clarify election offences, add new ones and strengthen the Election Commission's legal authority.
5. **Enacting Political Financing Act:** To regulate funding sources and expenditure of candidates and parties to ensure transparency.
6. **Reforming Election Commissioner Appointment Process:** To form an Electoral Commissions Nomination Committee (ECNC) with eight representatives from different branches of government and CSOs to nominate election commissioners.
7. **Strengthening Independence of MACC:** To improve the mechanism for appointing the MACC chief commissioner by amending the Federal Constitution and the MACC Act 2009.
8. **Separating AG and PP's roles:** The Attorney General will be government's legal adviser while a newly set up independent Public Prosecutor's Office will be in charge of prosecutions.
9. **Enacting Ombudsman Act:** To establish an independent investigative body under Ombudsman to address public complaints.
10. **Enacting Asset Declaration Act:** To make asset declaration mandatory for elected representatives and senators.
11. **Enacting Government Procurement Act:** To ensure a transparent, accountable and competitive public procurement system.
12. **Enacting Freedom of Information Act:** To establish clear parameters for accessing information from public bodies and the government.
13. **Amending Whistleblower Protection Act:** To encourage and facilitate disclosure of improper conduct and strengthen whistleblower protection.

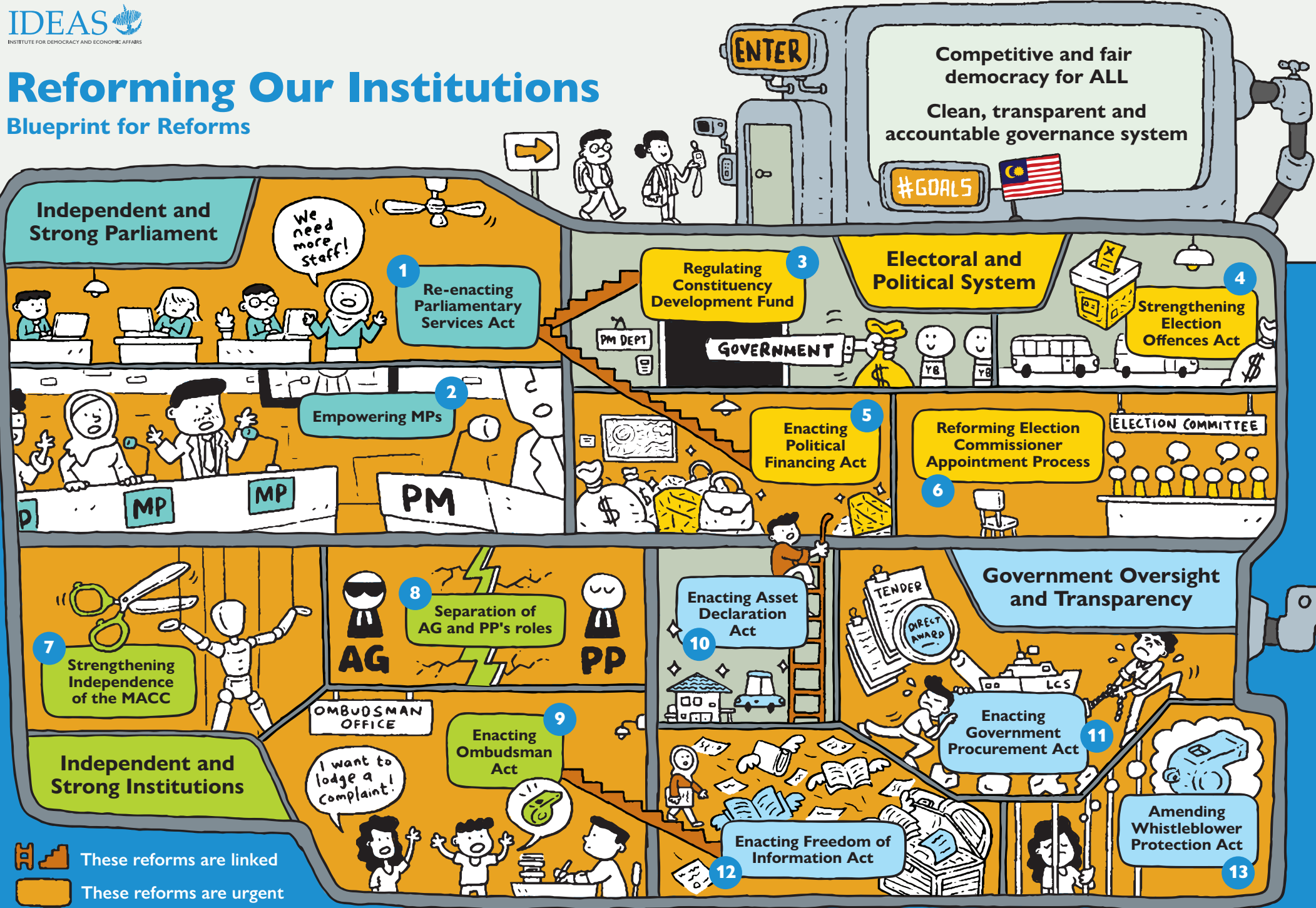
IDEAS with our civil society organization partners recognise that institutional reforms are interlinked with one another. This blueprint visualises the linkages as well as the urgency of the reforms.
